Eligibility Requirements

This \$1,000.00 scholarship is to provide assistance to an undergraduate student. Applicants to the scholarship program must be a female resident of Dauphin County and in her final year of secondary education. Additionally, the student applicant must be a registered Republican or if too young to register, a parent and/or guardian must be registered as a Republican.

This scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding female student who is selected by the DCCRW Scholarship Committee on the basis of Academic Performance and Leadership Potential as demonstrated by high school grades, Scholastic Achievement Test scores and extra-curricular activities. A Letter of Recommendation must also be completed.
